

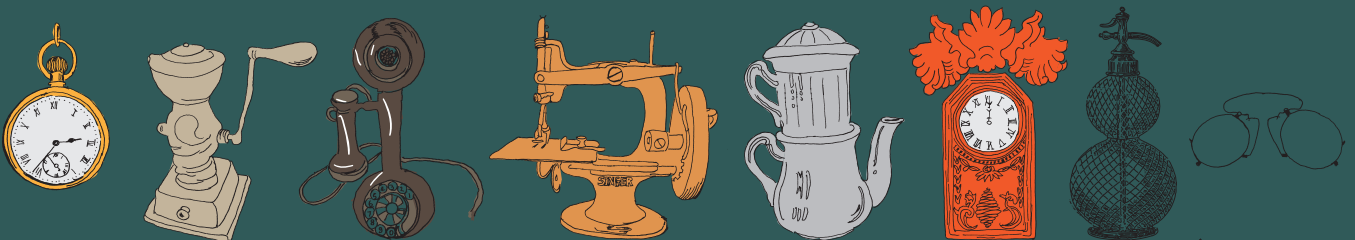
ON SHOW AT WILLOUGHBY MUSEUM, CHATSWOOD, FROM 21 APRIL 2013

celebrating 100 years

The exhibition celebrates the centenary of *Boronia*, the Federation cottage that now houses the museum, and explores residential development in Chatswood following the opening of the North Shore Railway in January 1890. It highlights the unique characteristics of land subdivisions and features several of the grand homes built in south Chatswood up to the 1920s, with examples of the items used in these homes. It concludes with the efforts of the community to conserve its local heritage, resulting in the establishment of the South Chatswood Conservation Area.
