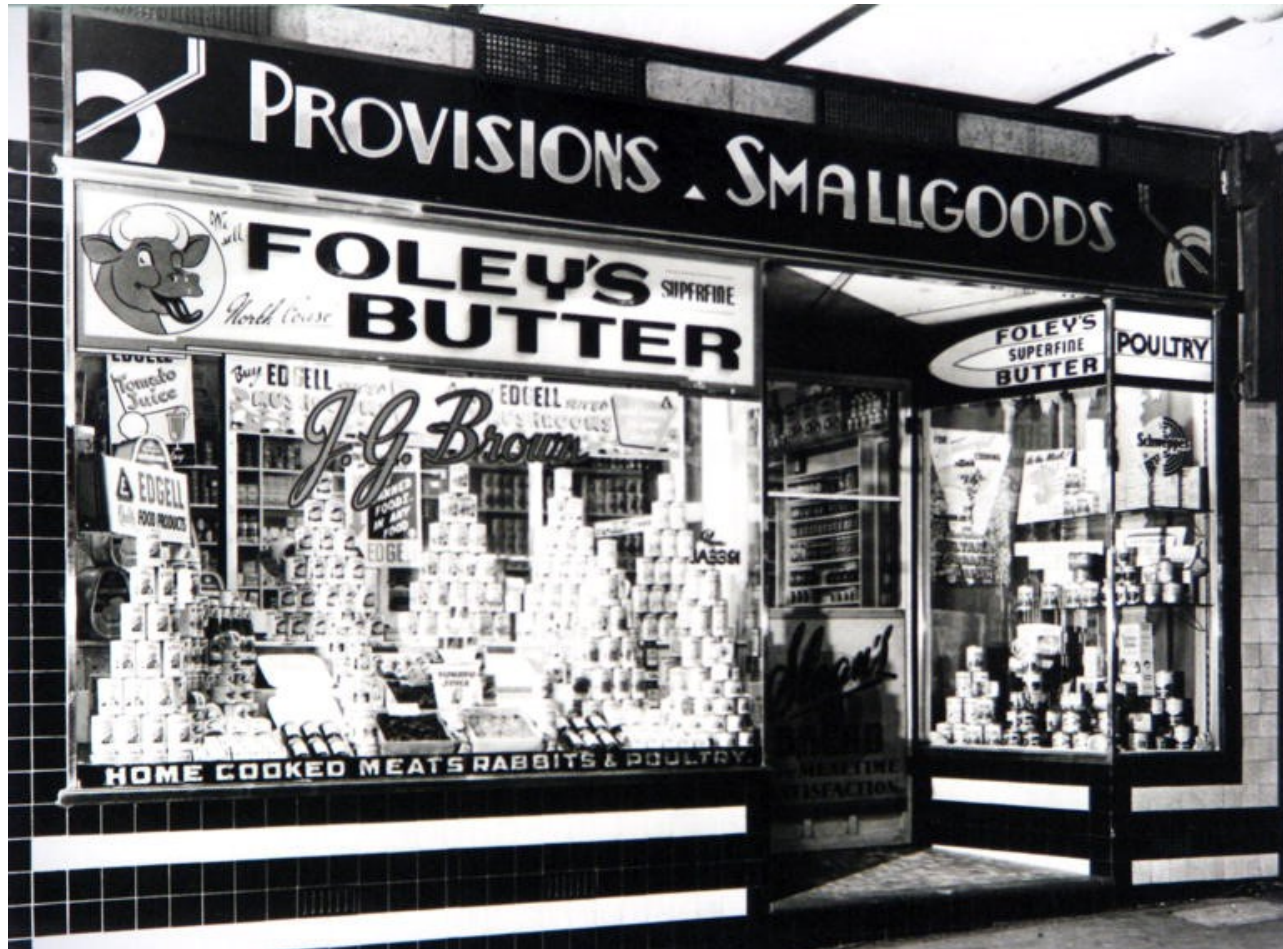


## CHANGING FOOD HABITS IN WILLOUGHBY 2

The opening of the major Chatswood Chase Shopping Mall in 1983 followed by the Westfield Mall on 3 January 1986, brought new shopping experiences for Willoughby and North Shore residents. Both of these facilities have been substantially upgraded over the years with revamped food halls and new restaurants offering a wide range of international cuisine.

Additional ventures came with the opening of The Concourse in April 2013, which brought expanded library facilities, music and drama theatres and additional restaurants offering a range of international cuisines. The opening of Hawkers Lane in Westfield in November 2015 brought a new dimension to dining experiences. Together, these facilities have attracted large numbers of visitors to the Chatswood Central Business District.
