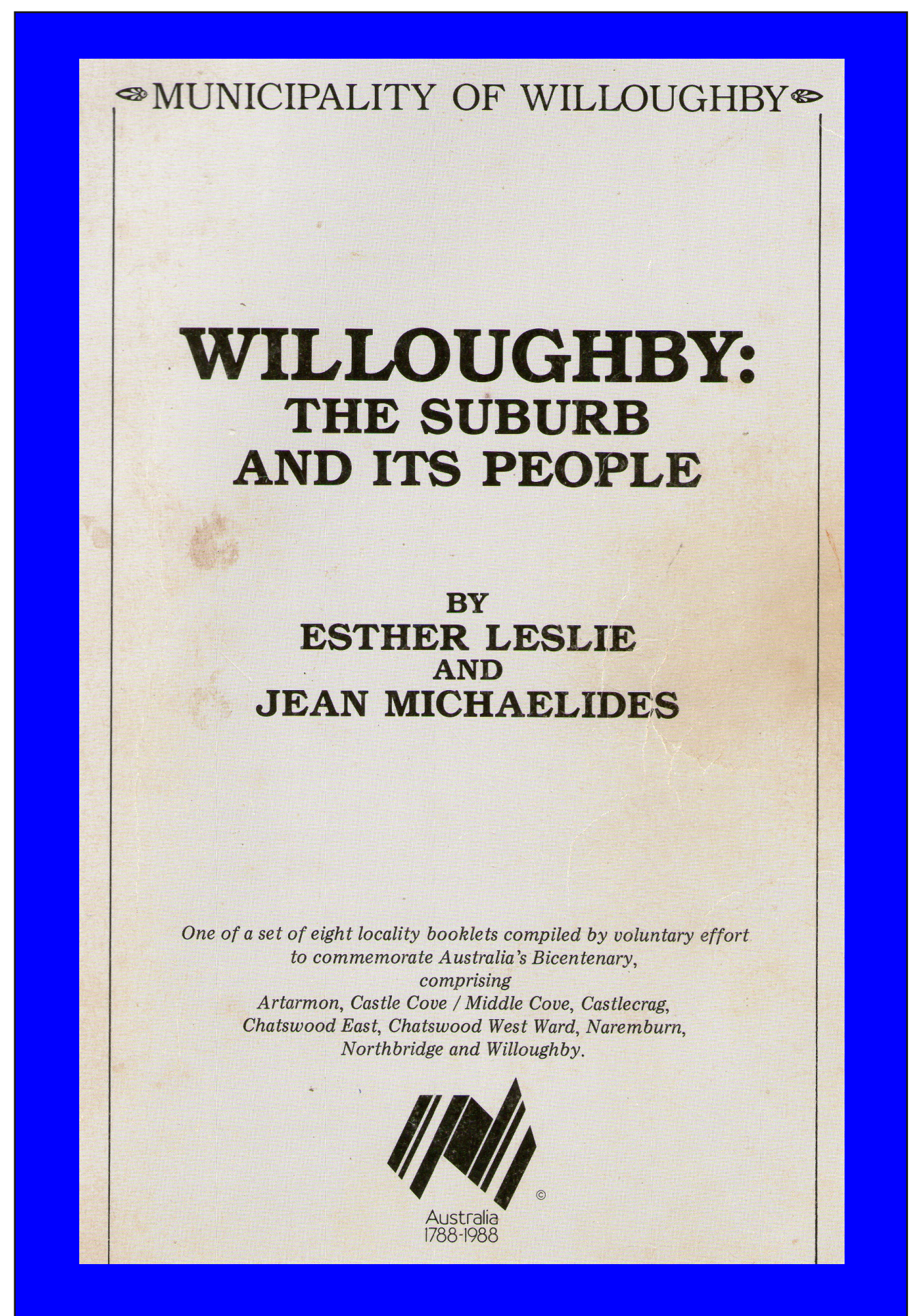


Bicentennial books

In 1983 Willoughby Municipal Council established a Willoughby Bicentennial Community Committee to manage, on a voluntary basis, Council's involvement in Australia's Bicentenary celebrations in 1988. It comprised members of the community and representatives of Council. The Committee set up several subcommittees within its infrastructure, including a 'Community History Projects Subcommittee' which unanimously decided to compile historical booklets on each of the nine suburbs in the present-day Municipality of Willoughby; locality boundaries to be local government boundaries irrespective of postcodes. An exception was made for the booklet on Chatswood West in favour of the boundaries of the West Ward.
